Students bring max 3 items of clothing (sweaters, shirts and t-shirts, pants, tracksuit) they don't use anymore to swap.

It's a donation, items not swapped will be donated by the school to local well known associations that work with people and families in need in our area.





Children receive a paper coin with a stamp on it for each item they deliver; teachers check the clothes and receive only ones in good condition.

During the swap day children can select a number of items to take home according to the number of items they delivered.

Parents committee will be involved to volunteer at the Swap Party event.
